THE WORLD CLASS GARDEN THAT'S ALWAYS IN SEASON!

Tower Hill Botanic Garden is more than a destination; it's a memorable horticultural experience. Less than an hour from Boston, Tower Hill is truly a year-round garden paradise. Situated on 132 acres in Boylston MA, the heart of Worcester County, Tower Hill is an extraordinary setting for a variety of garden styles—both educational and stunningly beautiful. It is the home of the Worcester County Horticultural Society, founded in 1842 to “advance the science, and encourage and improve the practice of horticulture.”

The distinctive gardens at Tower Hill display the breadth and beauty of the finest horticulture in New England. The **Systematic Garden** is a unique educational experience where plants are arranged according to a scientific classification system, in the sequential order by which they evolved on Earth. The intimate **Vegetable Garden** is planted according to a different theme each year with unusual and striking vegetables and fruits. Beyond the formal gardens, walking trails through native woodlands—interspersed with garden ornaments—are open in all seasons. The panoramic views of Mt. Wachusett and the Wachusett reservoir from Tower Hill's **Belvedere** are breathtaking.

Tower Hill's two glass houses—the **Orangerie** and the **Limonaia**—contain blooming, non-hardy plants from around the world, with an emphasis on those from the southern hemisphere and Mediterranean region. Visitors enjoy spectacular displays of citrus, palm trees, bananas, and many other plant species throughout fall and winter. A Latin inscription over the glass doors of the Orangerie translates to “If there be heaven on earth, surely this is it, joy everlasting,” offering the visitor a hint of the lush, green jungle waiting inside.

The outdoor **Winter Garden**, flanked by the two glass houses, showcases plant specimens that are especially valued for their winter ornamental features, including unusual blooming periods, interesting bark, and colorful berries. A geometric-shaped pool in the center enhances the garden with its whimsical turtle fountains that shoot dueling streams of water year-round.

Families and children are especially drawn to Tower Hill because it engages their imagination and inspires a curiosity about plants, animals and the natural world. The Garden openly welcomes all generations and accommodates their special needs in a relaxed manner.

TOWER HILL AMENITIES

The Stoddard Education and Visitors Center is the hub for all activities at Tower Hill Botanic Garden. Visitors can see an introductory video, pick up a map of the grounds, and ask questions at the Reception Desk in the **Morgan Reception Gateway**. Visitors may also shop for gardening tools, unique gifts, books, clothing, toys and souvenirs in **The Shop At Tower Hill**. **Twigs Café** provides delicious light fare in an unparalleled atmosphere. A selection of beers and wines are also available. Free wireless internet service is available to enhance your study of the Garden. The cultivated areas are accessible to the physically challenged, and wheelchairs are available.

Knowledgeable guides offer a tour of the Garden every Sunday at 2^{pm}; specialized tours with specific topics can be arranged for your group. Parties of 10 or more are eligible for discounted admission rates. Boxed lunches suited to your dietary requirements may be ordered in advance from Twigs Café.
